Coach Tim Bradbury, is a native of Great Britain. His extensive resume includes professional tours with several clubs there as player/coach. In the US, he was Coach of York College and the L.I. Rough Rider U-17 Youth team as well as numerous other youth club teams on Long Island. He was Technical Director for Eastern NY Girls ODP for several years and is currently a member of the Regional ODP coaching staff. He holds numerous licenses including a USSF National "A"; USSF National Youth; NSCAA National Goalkeeper Diploma and NSCAA Master Coach Award and a F.A. (British) teaching certificate. He has conducted clinics for Author Tony Waiters, is an adjunct member of the NSCAA Coaching Academy and clinician at the NSCAA National Coaches convention.
